KEY POINT:

Peter wants us to live lives of loving others because we are His precious children.

PRAY for God's help as you come to His Word
READ 1 PETER 1V13-21



Last week in v3-12 Peter reminded why it is a huge privilege to be God's elect exiles. In this passage Peter wants us that we are God's holy precious children.

- 1) How are Christians meant to live in v13?
 - a) Why are we meant to live this way?
 - b) How does the "Therefore" at the start of the verse help us know why we should live this way?
- 2) How are Christians described in v14-16?
 - a) Why are we described this way?
 - b) How are we not meant to live now?
 - c) What are the evil desires of our hearts?
 - d) What were we ignorant of when we lived this way?
 - e) How are we meant to live now?*
 - f) Why are meant to live holy lives?
- 3) How should we live now v17-21?
 - a) Why should we live now fearing God?
 - b) What has God done for us? What did this cost him?
 - c) What does Jesus death tell us about how God sees us?
 - d) How does knowing Jesus died for you help you to fear God?

*Note: Being holy means to be different to those we are not God's people.



1. Having looked at this passage are you more persuaded that that it is important to live differently to those who are not Christians? Why?
2. How does this passage help you to stand as a Christian in the face of trials?
3. How does knowing that God gave Jesus to die for us help you to want to obey Him?
4. If you don't know Jesus do you want to?
